

## **Southend Wheelers**

### **Easter Egg 10 miles Time Trial.**

**Monday March 28<sup>th</sup> 2016**

**Course E21/10 Steeple, Start 09.00. This is a 'Come and Try It' event.**

**Headquarters; Steeple Village Hall that is in the road opposite the Star Pub. Open at 08.00 for signing on and collection of numbers. Please park sensibly as parking is limited.**

**Entry fee is £3.50, (£2.50 for junior riders under18), £2 of which is a CTT Levy. Pay when signing on.**

**All junior riders under 18 on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 will need to present a CTT Club Event Parental Consent Form for 2016 made out to Southend Wheelers and signed in the presence of a Southend Wheelers official/timekeeper by apparent or guardian. These forms can be downloaded from the CTT website.**

**The course description and a map will be displayed at the HQ. If you are not familiar with the course, please ask for guidance when signing on. Please arrive to sign on by 08.40 latest.**

**Novices to time trials should note that you must ride alone and unaccompanied, no taking pace from other riders (drafting) and no leading or following vehicles. Please do not arrive at the start more than five minutes before your start time. Please do not approach the timekeepers while they are timing. Call out your number at the finish.**

#### **Local CTT regulations.**

**No 'U' turns within sight of the start and finish. This dangerous manoeuvre can result in disqualification and possible disciplinary action by CTT.**

**In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL SAFETY HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. All juniors or riders and/or riders under the age of 19 years are required to wear a suitably approved helmet. Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters recommend the use of a flashing rear light whilst competing.**

**In respect for consideration of local residents, static trainers e.g. turbo trainers is banned in all morning events in the London East District.**

**No warming up on the course is allowed after the event has started.**

**Riders must keep a good lookout ahead at all times and must obey the normal MOT rules of the road and give way to other traffic and riders who have right of way at road junctions etc.**

**The course will be marshalled at all turns and any warning given by marshals should be heeded.**

**You must take note of any hazards mentioned on the risk assessment or by officials at the HQ or start.**

**Have a safe and enjoyable ride.**
